Gift Aid Declaration – Appleshaw Church (St. Peter-in-the-Wood)

A Gift Aid declaration allows charities to claim tax back on eligible donations. Appleshaw Church (St. Peter-in-the-Wood) (the “Church”) will use this Gift Aid form to demonstrate to HM Revenues & Customs that you (the donor) wish to make donations with Gift Aid to the Church.
